The Seafox Fleet



Since 1991, Workfox has been the exclusive manager responsible for the operation of the Seafox fleet. The self-elevating accommodation and maintenance support units are all specifically designed and built to operate in harsh offshore environmental conditions, in particular in the Southern North Sea. The various units can accommodate up to 235 POB (Persons On Board) in single and double cabins and meet the latest high standards of hygiene and comfort.

After recent major upgrades, the Seafox units comply with latest North Sea standards and legislation. The current high standard of the accommodation and all related facilities, is maintained through a continuous welfare improvement program, which is compiled and monitored in co-operation with clients. With sufficient free deck space and multiple cranes, the units are capable of operating year-round in water depths of up to 55 metres.

Life onboard is pleasant and comfortable thanks to facilities such as a cinema, a gymnasium with state-of-the-art fitness equipment, a satellite entertainment system, hospital facilities, internet and e-mail facilities, client meeting rooms and offices.

Temporary Living Quarters

On behalf of owners, Workfox offers a flexible rental package for temporary living quarters for offshore locations and on board ships. These TLQs are Lloyd's (LRS) certified and comply with all relevant governmental and class specifications applicable in the North Sea.

Designed to address the need for a flexible solution for various accommodation requirements, the TLQs have a number of enhanced features that make them efficient for installation on oil and gas production sites offshore. External hook-up services are conveniently located to facilitate safe and quick connection to the host installation.

The units are relatively light and have a small footprint, which allows for easy, cost-effective transportation and positioning. These recently-built TLQs confirm the proven concept of combining comfort with practical efficiency to an ever growing number of clients. The fleet comprises approximately 60 units, varying from living quarters, offices, recreation and laundry units and changing rooms.

Design

Workfox's many years of experience in the offshore accommodation market have resulted in a special design that conforms to specific recommendations. Each unit is divided into two bedrooms allowing two-person occupancy, with a dedicated wet area providing a fully self-contained bathroom with shower, wash basin and toilet. The TLQs are stackable to a maximum of three high.



Our Commitment

Seafox jack-up units are managed by an integrated management system established using the United Kingdom Health and Safety Executive guidelines referred to as publication HSG 65 (principles of successful Health and Safety Management). Workfox's proven management system covers Quality, Safety and Environmental issues, all on an equal basis.

A QA/Safety Manager is employed on a full-time basis in order to safeguard the priority of Health and Safety issues within the organisation and its operations.
